More speed, less spinning your wheels

The good news? Early previews of Version 4 show a clear boost in speed and performance. We appreciate your patience and support as we work towards delivering a faster, smoother BoardSpace experience — one that makes the wait worthwhile.

Meeting Creation & Work Flow

Version 4 brings introduces several improvements.

Meetings are now organized into two sections: current and Agendas and minutes begin as drafts, so you control exactly when they are shared with directors. approved.

The result is a cleaner workflow with better control over information flow..

Bringing AI to Minutes

Our most exciting addition is AI-powered minutes.

Add rough notes, audio, or a transcript—and let BoardSpace generate a structured first draft in minutes. Recording secretaries remain fully in control, with the ability to review, edit, and finalize before sharing.

Consider how much faster and easier it will be, eliminating hours of post-meeting work.

Tentative Launch Date

Our tentative plan is to launch in early June, with more details to be announced closer to the date.
